

## CERTIFICATION INFORMATION FOR ADJUSTERS, AGENTS, BROKERS, LAW ENFORCEMENT, AND ATTORNEYS

Attendees of the Conference may go to the CDAA.org home page to download a "Certificate of Attendance." Under the Training Department section near the bottom of the CDAA home page there are download links. Attendees will have different requirements and purposes for these forms, such as MCLE, CEC or POST. If, after reading the details below, we can assist with any special need please let us know.

For Attorneys, the California District Attorneys Association has certified that 16.75 MCLE hours may be obtained, including four hours of Ethics. Through the CDAA link, MCLE certificates may be obtained.

For Law Enforcement, all the two-hour courses were POST Certified, and eligible attendees can obtain a maximum of ten hours of POST credits. The POST Control Number is 8910-28000-09-0002. Post certification is done through the California Department of Insurance.

For Adjusters, Agents and Brokers, all the two-hour courses were certified by the California Department of Insurance, and eligible attendees can obtain a maximum of ten hours of Continuing Education Credits, including four hours of Ethics. Per applicable CCR and CIC sections, the California Department of Insurance will mail certificates reflecting each class attended by agents, brokers and adjusters, according to the sign up sheets at the conference.
